The EurOCEAN 2010 Conference will take place in Ostend, on 12-13 October 2010 and will provide a unique opportunity for the European marine science community to consider, discuss and respond to new policy developments and achievements since the last EurOCEAN conference (2007, Aberdeen), and to highlight new challenges and opportunities for marine research in the next decade.
