Mesozooplankton Taxonomy Intercalibration Workshop

27-30 May 2008

HCMR, Greece, 27-30 May 2008

An intercalibration workshop on the taxonomy of mesozooplankton has been planned in order to analyse historical zooplankton data (T 1.2 of WP1) as well the taxonomic analysis of the samples which are under collection within the WP2 and WP3 cruises. During the workshop the classification of several mesozooplankton taxa will be checked among SESAME's WP1, WP2, WP3 partners. This intercalibration will concern dominant and common species in the Mediterranean and Black Seas. In addition, there is a need to discuss the elaboration of historical data by statistical methods for WP1 purposes. The workshop will be held in HCMR (Anavyssos) from 27 till 30 May 2008 and it will focus on taxonomy for the first three days (27-29 May), while the last day (30 May) is dedicated to data elaboration. For the taxonomy part of the workshop the number of participants will be limited to the scientists who have done (WP1) or will do (WP2, WP3) the taxonomic analysis of the samples. For the elaboration of data, all WP1 partners are invited to participate.
