

SESAME Publication Strategy

In accordance with the FP6 Rules and the SESAME Contract (Annex II, Article 33.3) and the Consortium Agreement, all partners must notify the Project Management Office of any forthcoming publications relating to the project within 30 days of its proposed submission. This notice should be in the form of an abstract of the proposed publication, the list of authors and where it will be submitted. The Management Office will publish this notice on the web page (under 'partners only' - 'publications') so that all members of the Consortium can view it, and notify the Commission. The Consortium and Commission then have a maximum of 30 days to object to the publication. Beyond this period, this consent shall be deemed to have been given.

All publications relating to SESAME project should acknowledge the project and Commission funding by quoting the project name and contract number. A suitable phrase to use is:

This research was supported by the SESAME project, EC Contract No GOCE-036949, funded by the European Commission's Sixth Framework Programme under the priority 'Sustainable Development, Global Change and Ecosystems'.

Authors must also include a statement that the publication reflects only the views of the authors and that the EC is not liable for any use that may be made of the information contained therein.
